Class 3	Beginners Working Hunter Pony / Horse – 45cm Class will be split as follows Section A - Cradle Stakes (Riders 10 years or under) Section B - Beginner / Nervous Horse / Pony (Rider any age).
Class 4	Rookie Working Hunter Pony / Horse – 55cm Class will be split as follows Section A -Nursery Stakes (Riders 12 years or under) Section B - Beginner / Nervous Horse / Pony (Rider any age).

## Working Hunter Training Stakes Specific Rules:

### Scoring as Follows:

Jumping	(Max Mark)	75
Style	(Max Mark)	15
Overall Impression	(Max Mark)	<u>10</u>
		100

- No individual show is required
- In the event of a tie, the placings will be decided according to the marks for each section in the following order: Jumping – Style – Overall Impression.
- If there is still a tie, then the judge's decision will be final.

### Jumping Penalties:

10	-	Knockdown
15	-	1 <sup>st</sup> Refusal
20	-	2 <sup>nd</sup> Refusal
Elimination	-	3 <sup>rd</sup> Refusal
Elimination	-	Fall of rider or horse / pony

- All competitors must be dressed in correct show attire
- Riding hats to current BRC standards
- All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or older
- Only horses and ponies competing at the show are allowed in the collecting ring

# General Rules for Competing with us.

## **IN ENTERING THIS COMPETITION YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING:-**

- \* A CHARGE FOR CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS EVENT FIRST AID WILL BE INCLUDED IN YOUR ENTRY FEES.
- \* WHEN MOUNTED ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR HARD HATS CONFORMING TO CURRENT BRC STANDARDS.
- \* ANY COMPETITORS WHOSE HORSES ARE WARMED UP BY ANOTHER RIDER WILL BE ASKED TO COMPETE HORS CONCOURS.
- \* PLEASE PARK CONSIDERATELY AND ALLOW ACCESS FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES TO THE ARENA & WARM UP ARENA AT ALL TIMES.
- \* PLEASE TAKE ALL RUBBISH HOME OR USE BINS PROVIDED AND CLEAR UP ALL DROPPINGS, SPILT HAY ETC.
- \* NO UNATTENDED CHILDREN OR BUGGIES TO BE IN OR NEAR THE ARENA OR WARM UP AREA AT ANY TIME.
- \* FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR HORSE AND OTHERS AROUND YOU, PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANY HORSE TIED UP & UNATTENDED TO YOUR BOX / TRAILER.
- \* THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE ALTERATIONS TO CLASSES ON THE DAY.
- \* ANY HORSE/PONY OR RIDER DEEMED BY THE STEWARDS TO BE A DANGER TO OTHERS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE VENUE.
- \* ANY PERSON PARTICIPATING, IN ANY WAY, AT A TVRC COMPETITION/EVENT WILL CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN A RESPECTFUL MANNER AT ALL TIMES.
- \* ANY PERSONS GUILTY OF A BREACH OF BRC CODES OF CONDUCT (RULE G5) WHICH CAUSES DISTRESS TO OTHERS OR BRINGS THE NAME OF AN AFFILIATED CLUB OR THE BRC IN TO DISREPUTE MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE VENUE & SHALL BE DEALT WITH BY THE CLUB COMMITTEE ACCORDING TO THE CLUB CONSTITUTION.

### ANIMAL WELFARE:

- \* TOWY VALLEY RIDING CLUB EXPECTS ALL THOSE INVOLVED IN IT'S EVENTS TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING CODE OF CONDUCT AND TO ACKNOWLEDGE AND ACCEPT THAT AT ALL TIMES THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE MUST BE PARAMOUNT.
- \* PONIES OR HORSES MAY ONLY COMPETE IN TVRC COMPETITIONS FROM 1 JANUARY IN THE YEAR IN WHICH THEY BECOME 4 YEARS OLD, EXCEPT FOR HORSE TRIALS WHEN THE MINIMUM AGE IS 5 YEARS OLD.
- \* NO TRAINING METHODS WHICH ARE ABUSIVE OR CAUSE HARM/FEAR TO THE HORSE/PONY WILL BE TOLERATED IN THE WARM ARENA OR VENUE.
- \* ABUSE OF A HORSE USING NATURAL RIDING AIDS OR ARTIFICIAL AIDS (E.G. WHIPS, SPURS ETC.) WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
- \* HORSES AND COMPETITORS MUST BE FIT, COMPETENT AT THE LEVEL THEY ARE TO COMPETE IN AND IN GOOD HEALTH.
- \* NO HORSE SHOWING SYMPTOMS OF DISEASE, LAMENESS OR OTHER SIGNIFICANT AILMENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.

### SHOW JUMPING SPECIFIC RULES:

- \* NO RESTRICTIONS ON HOW MANY CLASSES YOU WISH TO ENTER, UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE IN THE SPECIFIC SCHEDULE.
- \* THE COMPETITION IS HELD UNDER BRC RULES, A FULL SET WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE DAY.
- \* ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEAR SHOW JACKETS AND A COLLAR WHILST JUMPING.
- \* COMPETITORS ARE ADVISED TO WEAR A BODY PROTECTOR WHEN JUMPING.
- \* A MAXIMUM NUMBER OF **10 HORSES ONLY** WILL BE ALLOWED INTO THE PRACTICE ARENA AT ANY ONE TIME, THIS MAYBE CHANGED AT ANY TIME FOR YOUR SAFETY.
- \* PLEASE PASS LEFT TO LEFT WITH THE SLOWER HORSE/PONY ON THE INSIDE TRACK.
- \* ONLY JUMP THE PRACTICE FENCE IN THE DIRECTION THAT IT IS FLAGGED. (RED ON THE RIGHT) & SHOULD NOT EXCEED THE HEIGHT & SPREAD OF THE CLASS IN PROGRESS

### PIBWRLWYD CAMPUS RULES:- (These are in addition to any other venue rules and those of the club)

- \* **DO NOT PARK NEAR ENGINEERING BLOCK OR, IN ANY PLACE WHICH MAY BLOCK ACCESS FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES.**
- \* NO DOGS (OTHER THAN GUIDE DOGS) ALLOWED ON COLLEGE CAMPUS.
- \* NO SMOKING ON THE PREMISES. (A SMOKERS SHELTER IS AVAILABLE) NO OPEN FLAME OR COOKING APPARATUS IS TO BE USE IN ANY AREA OF THE EQUINE CAMPUS.
